#### **Other Comments on the Thesis**

Theoretical part: many literary references are used, many of which are insignificant in the field. I would expect to work with much better primary sources.

#### Practical part:

- lacks hypotheses development, it is not clear how the author defined the hypotheses and research questions that interest him. I consider this to be a very serious mistake.
- the results depend on the input primary data, which is also reflected in the quality of the results and conclusions of the master thesis.
- the aim of the work was to focus on financial and non-financial instruments. Again, due to the quality of the available data, some non-financial instruments are relatively marginal.
- the sample size is not sufficiently described, the characteristics of the research sample of companies are missing.
- it was not sufficiently satisfactorily explained why the author focus on the V4 countries.
- recommendations (chapter 5.2) are very theoretical, difficult to apply in practice.

I blame the author for the formal modification of the tables, which does not comply with the requirements.
