Other Comments on the Thesis

The purpose of the presented thesis had been seen in exposing the significance of the immigration impacts on selected important areas of economic and social development - on the ground of accessible data related to the major migration flows and stocks. The study has been conceived as a combination of relevant theoretical knowledge, creating prevailing current models and concepts and findings arising from elaboration the information linked with examined areas. The composition and framework of the thesis has been set up in a logical, standard manner to cover theoretical background, methodological solutions and analysis of data and information available. Observable that the study has special assets in its theoretical part where author seeks, beside characterization of respected general migration models, theoretical interpretation of the immigration context in pursued subject areas addressed further in the empirical section. As far as the methodological means are concerned, the fact is that the range of potential approaches and procedures includes many other options. Considering the aims of analysis, however, the applied methodological approach is sufficient. Author mostly deals in analytical chapter with quantitative changes of economic and social terms brought about by immigration. This way is comprehensible regarding his possibilities of more extensive field research. It should be pointed out that the adequate attention has been paid to the observed phenomena on the level of selected regions and to the comparisons of these regions in terms of applied criteria. As has been implicitly defined in the assignment of the thesis, analysis has been confined to the data referring to the development in Czechia's spatial framework. Even though the Conclusion has been elaborated rather generally, they indicate the findings that represent "value added" of the study. It can be stated the aim of the presented thesis has been accomplished. The way of forming the text and wording are satisfactory. There are some minor imperfections in terms of formulations and content (e.g. p. 93 above: "Low fertility, old age.....balancing the effects of low fertility, old age....") but they do not devalue the argumentation.

Comments on the Outputs from the Theses System

Finding out the degree of sameness as for other texts revealed not negligible rate of identity. In the sections indicated as affirmative, the identity has been detected mostly as mentioning formal designations, presenting names, definitions, formal information and the like – without substantial influence on the authenticity of the work.
